Counting of the votes at the Presidential election 2025 has finished with the ascertainment of the result at the central count centre in Dublin Castle. The Presidential Returning Officer, Mr Barry Ryan, has announced the result and declared Catherine Connolly to stand elected to the Office of President of Ireland.

In accordance with the Presidential Elections Act, 1993, the Presidential Returning Officer will formally inform the President, the President elect, the Taoiseach, the Chief Justice, the Chairman of the Dáil, the Chairman of the Seanad and the Secretary to the President, of the election of the President.

The Presidential Returning Officer will communicate the details of the voting to the Taoiseach, to the Minister for Housing, Local Government and Heritage and to the President elect.
